

Caesarstone Porcelain Maintenance, Use and Care Guidelines

Step-by-Step Care

Everyday Cleaning

- 1. Wipe the surface with a soft cloth or a non-abrasive scorer dipped in warm water with a mild detergent. Rinse with water, and dry with a soft cloth or paper towel.
- 2. Always wipe up wet spills to prevent a patina from forming.
- 3. Check each cleaning product on an inconspicuous area to ensure that it doesn't damage the surface. Patina's build-up may look like a light-coloured stain.
- 4. Honed and Ultra Rough finishes are more prone to metal marks, fingerprints, and other signs of daily use, which can easily be removed with non-abrasive cleaning products such as CIF cream. Do not polish the surface with a polishing machine.

Stubborn Stains

- 1. Gently rub the area using a soft cloth or paper towel with an approved cleaner.
- 2. Clean a larger area in a circular motion than the stain
- 3. Rinse with water, and dry with a soft cloth or paper towel.



4. Repeat this process if the stain is still visible.

Dried Spills

- 1. Dried spills and stains should be reanimated with water for several minutes before attempting recommended cleaning methods.
- 2. Clean the surface with a damp cloth or paper towel.

Metal Marks

- 1. Rub gently with a latex eraser.
- 2. Clean the surface with a damp cloth or paper towel.

Rust Marks

- 1. Place an Astonish Barkeeper's Friend power spray or oxalic acid on a damp cloth. Do not use an abrasive scorer.
- 2. Wipe away very gently, in a circular motion.
- 3. Rinse thoroughly with warm water, and dry with a soft cloth or paper towel.
- 4. Follow these instructions carefully to avoid damaging the surface.
